

Accessibility Information

Oranssi's entrance, event space and toilet are at street level and are accessible with support devices of all sizes. However, some higher doorway thresholds and sloping ramps may be difficult for people using manual wheelchairs. The toilets are gender-neutral.

The main entrance has two doors. With both doors open the entrance is 136cm wide. When one door is open the entrance is 66cm wide. The doorstep has a 4cm threshold. The following ramp has a slope which is approximately 10% or 5.75 degrees. The both ends of the ramp have a 1.5cm bump.

After the entrance the toilet can be found on the left side. The first doorway is 84cm wide and the door opens outwards. Inside there are two toilet rooms and the one on the left is larger. Both rooms have a toilet seat, a sink and a trash bin but no bidéé.

The larger room's doorway is 82cm wide and the door opens outwards. In between the left side of the toilet seat and the door there is 129 cm of free space. The front of toilet seat has 80cm of free space and the right side has 76cm of free space. Both side of the toilet seat has handrails with adjustable height and angle. The sink is 85cm high. Under the sink there is a 79cm high, 90.5cm wide and 59cm deep free space.

The doorway of the smaller room is 53cm wide. There is only a small 44cm free space in between the corner of the sink and the wall.

The hallway to the event space has two fire proof doors. Both doors open the width of the entrance is 145cm and one door open 96,5cm. The door is heavy, but can be held open by a hinge in the wall of the entrance hall. There is a threshold of about 3cm at the doorway.

Before the doorway from the bigger hall to the cafe studio lounge there is a 120cm wide wooden ramp with a slope of about 8% or 4.62 degrees. The width of the doorway is 178cm.

Unfortunately, there is no unobstructed access to the upstairs office and meeting room.

When entering the Suvilahti area, a smoother route to the Oranssi building is from the Sörnäinen rantatie. Coming from Kalasatama, you either have to use the staircase in front of Oranssi or go down the hill next to the New Circus Centre Cirko and go around the building.
